#### Speaker

William ("Bill") Lee Simpson, Jr. will be our speaker. His topic will be "The Battle of Cowpens." Bill is the Past President of VASSAR, and has held numerous other positions within VASSAR. He is a retired Navy Commander and currently teaches at Quantico Marine Base. The is the father of our own Associate William ("Will") Lee Simpson III.

#### John Frederick Dorman will be our special guest

John Frederick Dorman was born in Louisville Kentucky and graduated from the University of Louisville. He received his Masters from Emory University in Atlanta. After serving in the Army, he was the head curator of documents at the College of William and Mary.

He was named a fellow of the American Society of Genealogists in 1958, of the National Genealogical Society in 1962, and of the Virginia Genealogical Society in 1995. He is a founding associate and the earliest living associate of the Board for Certification of Genealogists (BCG), having earned his credential as certified genealogist number four in 1965. He served as president of BCG from 1979 to 1982 and as BCG Executive Director from 1982 to 1986. In 2004 he was awarded Emeritus status for "sustained excellence and service" to BCG. In 2006 the New England Historic Genealogical Society presented him the Coddington Award of Merit recognizing "the highest standard of excellence in American genealogical scholarship and lifetime achievement in the field."

He has served as the Genealogist General of numerous national lineage societies; and, is, without doubt, the leading authority on Virginia genealogy. He now lives in retirement in Stafford County.

#### Civil War Trust expands focus to Revolution, War of 1812

"On Veterans day, at the site of George Washington's first victory over the British, the Civil War Trust announced it will begin preserving battlefields from the Revolutionary War and the War of 1812. Its work to preserve Civil War battlefields will continue."

"The trust, which has preserved 40,000 acres of Civil War battlefields, believe there are approximately 10,000-15,000 acres of Revolutionary and 1812 battlefield sites worth protecting."

"Its first target will be 4.6 acres at the Princeton, N.J., battlefield, a 1777 engagement that is considered a turning point."

The Trust calls this effort The Campaign 1776 initiative.
