



About our Speaker:

For over 40 years Nick Luccketti has been surveying and excavating Virginia's historic sites for the Virginia Department of Historic Resources, the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation, and the Association for the Preservation of Virginia Antiquities (APVA).

He is one of the principal archaeologists at the James River Institute for Archaeology, Inc. and was one of the finders of James Fort of 1607. He is a recognized expert in excavation of early colonial sites and led a team of archaeologists in conducting test excavations on Roanoke Island. Additionally, he has led numerous archaeological research efforts focusing on the early history of Virginia.




Announcements

This is how the OFPA Handbook describes the OFPA flag.

"SECTION 3. COLORS. The colors of the Order shall consist of the National Colors or Flag as prescribed by an Act of Congress, and the colors of the flag of the Order. The latter shall be cross, Gules, on a field, Argent, with canton, Azure, a constellation of thirteen stars, Argent."
