**From Charlottesville.** Take **I-64 east** until you Take I-95 S/Richmond-Petersburg Turnpike toward thru Traffic. Then follow **from north** directions.

From Williamsburg. Get onto I-64W toward Richmond. Take the VA-33W/Nine Mile Rd exit, exit 193A. Turn slight right onto VA-33/Nine Mile Road. Continue to follow VA-33W. Turn right onto E. Broad Street/US-60. St. John's is on the left (just past N 24th Street)
