The Order of Founders and Patriots of America, and the War of 1812 in Virginia will do a joint grave marking ceremony at Ware Episcopal Church on Saturday, October 19, 2013. VA OFPA will mark the grave of Founder Richard Edwards. The War of 1812 in Virginia will be marking the graves of Patriots Catesby Jones and Philip M. Smith.

Richard Edwards was born in England and arrived 23 May 1637 in James City County.

He was originally buried at the Edwards Family cemetery, but in 1952, APV moved his head stone to Ware Episcopal Church.
