More than twenty hereditary organizations throughout the Commonwealth, and several from as far away as Georgia and Kentucky, were present to pay tribute to the patriotic event that took place on February 14, 1781. The Crossing of the Dan has been described as a "masterful military maneuver" that would mark the beginning of the defeat of the British by the American Patriots. 
SPEAKER: Mrs. Nancy Gailey Heuser. She is a Petersburg native whose third great grand-father was the last surviving member of the Petersburg Volunteers, Reuben Clements. Her talk will focus on the organization and march of the Volunteers and their pivotal role at the Battle of Fort Meigs. Petersburg is known as the "Cockade City" based on the exploits of the Volunteers which earn them the right to wear a cockade in their hats. Mrs. Heuser is a past president of the Virginia State Society United States Daughters of 1812.

2:30 p.m.: To Blandford Cemetery, - 319 South Crater Road, Petersburg, Virginia 23803- for a dedication of an 1812 Veteran's memorial plus a dedication of a Founders marker on the grave of Richard Yarborough. Richard Yarborough was born c1615 in Lincolnshire, England, and arrived in Virginia in 1635. He appears to have made several trips between England and Virginia. Richard and wife Francis Proctor had ten children. Richard Yarborough was one of the founders of Bristol Parish, Prince George County, Virginia. He died in 1702 at the age of 87. (Cemetery is ten minutes away and we can convoy.)



The award is the highest award presented by the Virginia Society and it is reserved for those members that display continual and exemplary service, to the Virginia Society, above and beyond the call of duty. The award was presented not to just one individual but to two individuals! The selection committee (Gov. Newcombe and past Gov. Cowardin) were unable to decide upon and/or select just one individual -- in that the society has two very committed and exceptional individuals, each clearly deserving of the Cavalier Award (an engraved silver plate from Cowardin's Jewelers Richmond VA). The individuals chosen for this award were Jerry Hubbard and Mike Lyman. The Virginia Society is extremely fortunate to have these two highly esteemed individuals. Our wholehearted thanks go out to both of these gentlemen for their tireless efforts in making the Virginia Society, the most distinguished Society within the OFPA Order!"

Past Governor Taylor Cowardin and Deputy Governor Walt Sheffield represented VA OFPA at the March 22, 2014 dedication of the memorial to Opechancanough's Attack of 22 Mar 1622. The plaque in part reads: "This monument is erected in memory of the English settlers who died in the 1622 indian attack that was organized by Chief Opechancanouch. On March 22, 1622, the Powhatan chiefdom launched a coordinated offensive against the English settlements along the James River. Sixty-six men, women and children were killed within the Henrico settlements including five dead at Henricus. Over one quarter of the English population of Virginia died in the attack."
